Videos

Most videos that are called out in Moon, Mars, and ISS are available from www.unitedstreaming.com. This company provides streaming video for education for subscribers. Check if the school has a subscription. If not, teachers can get a 30 day trial to use the service free of charge for their own classrooms. To get the free subscription, go to the website, click on the bottom left tab and follow the directions. You will get approved in a few minutes and will be on your way.

When you are in the website, do a search on the recommended titles. Once identified, download the program onto your computer. From there you will proceed to burn it onto a DVD. DVD-R has been recommended and works on my computer and DVD player.

If you have Intervideo WinDVD, you can proceed to write the DVD following these instructions.

- 1) Download desired video. Make sure it Windows and not QuickTime. (It will have a .wmv extension)
- 2) Open WinDVD Creator
- 3) Select Capture
- 4) Double click in large purple box on lower right to import download
- 5) Select desired video and click open
- 6) Click on edit (No. 2)
- 7) Drag video from upper right to lower left box
- 8) Insert blank DVD
- 9) Click on Make Movie in Win DVD creator (No. 4) and follow directions.
