Travel Brochure & Poster

- This project includes BOTH a travel brochure and a poster
- Poster should be general information along with pictures, etc.
- Brochure should be more detailed and informative
- Destination and specialty requirements must be included
- Format should be visually appealing

Board Game

- Game board representative of you destination
- Game pieces relating to your destination
- Rules must include:
 - o Goal of game
 - o How to play the game in detail
 - Who starts
 - o How to move
 - o Etc...
- Minimum of 10 questions cards from each member of the group
- Destination and specialty requirements must be included
- Format should be visually appealing

Knowledge Based Game: Game must have:

- 'Backdrop' representing your destination
- Rules must include:
 - o Goal of game
 - o How to play the game in detail
 - Who starts
 - o Etc...
- Questions using information based on specialties and destination
- Minimum of 10 questions cards from each member of the group
- Destination and specialty requirements must be included
- Format should be visually appealing

Power Point: Requirements

Introduction

- Brief description of your destination
- Minimum of 3 slides that cover some of the requirements
- Appealing description of your destination

Body

- Leads into the specialties
- 5 slides per specialty
- Covers requirements and modules

Conclusion

- Summary of why we should visit the destination.
- Include pros and cons of getting to, staying at, returning from your destination.
